Dear parents and carers

Happy New Year. We hope you are all managing to stay safe and well and have had a chance to enjoy the festive period.

As you are all aware, in line with strict new government guidelines, and to keep everyone safe, we must revert to teaching online as of Monday 11th January. Currently, the Scottish Government has stipulated that pupils should continue learning from home until 1st February but this will be kept under review and we will, of course, keep you updated about any changes.

We would much rather be in school, but we want to remind you that, even though we are not in the building, school is 'open', staff are here to help and support, and learning can, and should, still take place.

Tomorrow, we will email an individualised online timetable for you to discuss with your child. Your child's tutor will follow this up with a phone call later in the week to check if you have any concerns or questions. As always, communication is the key thing so please do let us know if there are any issues and we will try to help. And remember, you can contact your child's tutor by email at any time.

We want to keep all pupils and staff as safe as possible over these next few crucial weeks, which includes looking after both their physical and emotional wellbeing. We will be in touch with parents/carers and other professionals to establish if any pupils are entitled to further additional support arrangements as specified by the Scottish Government, and discuss what we can do to help with this.

We know this is another change for pupils and will be a challenge for many of them. We will miss seeing them at school but we will be online to support them, and tutors will keep in regular contact.
