Dear parents and carers

As you will all no doubt be aware, The Scottish Government announced last week that Scotland's Covid-19 lockdown is to be extended until the middle of February, with most school pupils continuing to learn from home. They advised that they hope schools will be able to at least begin a phased return to the classroom in the middle of next month.

We will therefore continue to follow this guidance and provide online teaching until the start of the February mid-term break (8-15 February).

The Scottish Government is due to review the return to school and the continuation of the wider lockdown on 2 February and we very much hope to be able to give you further information (and better news) following their announcement.

We know that learning from home is very challenging, both for parents and pupils, and we want to get back to school as soon as we are allowed and it is safe for everyone to do so. We are very grateful for your patience and support. We will be sending out some questions in the coming week to get your feedback about how things are going.
